Phil, BEAUPRE will be contacting you about having background checks done for those of you who are in a high risk position, such as money counters, those with keys to our churches and anyone who is going into people's homes to visit the sick, take communion etc, to anybody that's not their relative. Incidentally, I have to have a police check done every year which is a Diocesan requirement for all priests. There is no cost to you and the diocese handles the police checks. **Pre-Authorized Giving Plan** - Many parishes in our Diocese are offering this plan as a convenience for their parishioners. We are offering it at the request of several of our parishioners. To enroll, you must submit the form, in the brochure with your void cheque, before the 10th of the first month in order for your deduction to begin on the 20th of the same month.
