The **Canadian Missions Appeal** will take place **August 10th/11th**. This collection has two purposes: first, to support the work of Catholic Missions in Canada (CMIC) for needy dioceses across Canada; secondly, to help support Toronto's two "sister" dioceses in financial need. One is in northern Alberta, called the Archdiocese of Grouard-McLennan centred in Grand Prairie, Alberta; the second is located in the Northwest Territories, called the Diocese of Mackenzie-Fort Smith, centred in Yellowknife, N.W.T. This collection is divided as follows: 50 per cent for CMIC and 50 per cent for Toronto's two sister dioceses. Please be as generous as possible. (**NOTE:** this is a totally separate appeal from Mission Co-op)

Pre-Authorized Giving Plan - Many parishes in our Diocese are offering this plan as a convenience for their parishioners. We are offering it at the request of several of our parishioners. Some find it easier to support their church by having their donation automatically withdrawn from their bank account on the 20th of each month. This also ensures the ongoing support of our church when they are away. Many find this method more convenient as many of us are accustomed to paying our utilities in this manner. You will still have the option of placing your envelopes in the collection basket, especially for special collections. To enroll, you must submit the form, in the brochure with your void cheque, before the 10th of the first month in order for your deduction to begin on the 20th of the same month.
