Lent - What is Fasting and Abstinence?

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops decrees that the days of fasting and abstinence from eating meat in Canada are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting in the Latin Church is the limitation of food and drink – typically to one main meal and two smaller meals, with no solid foods in between. The **law of abstinence** binds those who are fourteen years of age and older. The **law of fasting**, however, binds all those who are eighteen to fifty-nine years of age. Nevertheless, pastors of souls and parents are to take care that minors not bound by the law of fast and abstinence are also educated in a genuine sense of penance. Especially during Lent abstinence from meat is practiced on Fridays. The rest of the year Fridays are days of abstinence, but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. **The Parent Registration Meeting for 1st**

Pre-Authorized Giving Plan - Many parishes in our Diocese are offering this plan as a convenience for their parishioners. We are offering it at the request of several of our parishioners. This also ensures the ongoing support of our church when they are away. Many find this method more convenient as many of us are accustomed to paying our utilities in this manner. To enroll, you must submit the form, in the brochure with your void cheque, before the 10th of the first month in order for your deduction to begin on the 20th of the same month.
