Help Not Harm: Take Action to Support Bill C-218 - Write your Member of Parliament Today!

Visit [HelpNotHarmCanada.ca](#) You’re invited to visit [HelpNotHarmCanada.ca](#) where you can e-mail your Member of Parliament (MP), asking for their support of **Bill C-218 (The Right to Recover Act)**, which would amend the Criminal Code to prevent Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) from being provided when mental illness is the sole underlying condition. Without this change, MAiD will be available for those suffering from mental illness alone beginning in March 2027. Chances are you know someone struggling with mental illness — a family member, friend, or colleague. Volunteer Screening-The ArchDiocese, on behalf of our insurance company, Catholic Mutual ins. has been asking us to screen our volunteers and now it’s time for us to do that. Phil, BEAUPRE will be contacting you about having background checks done for those of you who are in a high risk position, such as money counters, those with keys to our churches and anyone who is going into people’s homes to visit the sick, take communion etc, to anybody that’s not their relative. I ask you to be generous in your cooperation with Phil and yes, we have to do this or risk not being covered by our insurance if something does happen. Of course this keeps all of us safe. Incidentally, I have to have a police check done every year which is a Diocesan requirement for all priests. There is no cost to you and the diocese handles the police checks. I know this is an inconvenience for some of you, but I ask you to be generous in participating. It will only take a few minutes of your time. Pre-Authorized Giving Plan - Many parishes in our Diocese are offering this plan as a convenience for their parishioners. We are offering it at the request of several of our parishioners. Some find it easier to support their church by having their donation automatically withdrawn from their bank account on the 20th of each month. This also ensures the ongoing support of our church when they are away. Many find this method more convenient as many of us are accustomed to paying our utilities in this manner. You will still have the option of placing your envelopes in the collection basket, especially for special collections. To enroll, you must submit the form, in the brochure with your void cheque, before the 10th of the first month in order for your deduction to begin on the 20th of the same month.
